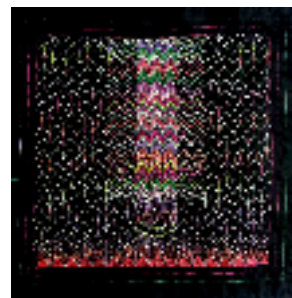
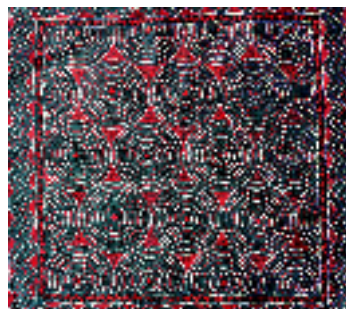

Indian embroideries “Kantha”

One finds Kantha embroideries in Bengal (East of India, in Bangladesh and Bihâr in the North-East of India). Kantha is a completed work of embroidery, originally done from remnants of cloth stacked in 4 or 5 layers, held together by embroidery with "forward stitch" by the women of the village. This is one of the oldest and most divers forms of embroidery.

Theme:

Transfer stencilled patterns of Kanthas embroidery on silk and eventually on linen.

Level: all
