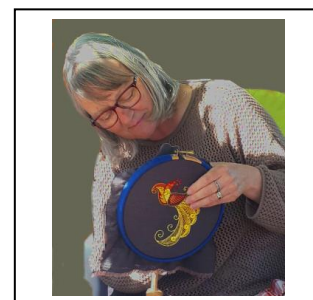

Descriptive : Pouch with Cilaos openwork and embroidery work with various materials (beads, threads, ribbons ...)

It is a technique that requires precision and solicits a lot the eyes. It is therefore aimed at people who already have experience.

Monik offers you the work of a pouch with 3 small Cilaos patterns or a large pattern mixed with a traditional embroidery work combining special threads (Oliver Twist thread) and pearls.

Price of the class : 195 € (kit additional)

Supplies :

Paid kit required : YES – 15€ to be paid on the spot to the artist

Content of the kit : the natural color linen for the pouch, the threads and pearls with a choice of colors, the needle.
(The lining of the cover is not provided).

Other supplies to bring : embroidery drum, small scissors and thimble

Miscellaneous : Cilaos

The embroidery of Cilaos has its origins from the island of Reunion. It was created by combining three sources of inspiration:

- white embroidery and openwork
- inspired patterns of local flora and fauna
- The Teneriffe lace: technique practiced by the Spanish in the sixteenth and seventeenth century.

Openwork of Cilaos are different from the old openwork of the sheets of our grandmothers by the technique used. Here the motifs are embroidered on stretched threads and not on the weft threads of the fabric. The work is done like the mending stitch on the barrettes of Richelieu or Hardanger.
